ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DEADLINE: 30th April 2022

All abstracts must be submitted through the online system on the Congress website and should be prepared in accordance to the instructions below.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Please read carefully the following instructions before proceeding the online submission

- 1. Submission of an abstract implies the commitment that the presenting author registers for the IX European Congress
- 2. Authors are requested to register within 5 days after having received their provisional notification of acceptance.
- 3. Abstract should be submitted via the express form here: https://congress2022.efcolposcopy.eu/abstract/
- 4. Abstracts must be submitted and presented in English;
- 5. The main author and the presenter must be identified;
- 6. If the abstract presenter is registered with a group, please inform the EFC Congress Secretariat at: efc.congress@thetriumph.com and indicate the person/company who made the group registration;
- 7. Abstracts will be peer reviewed and evaluated by experts in one of the categories (topics) listed. They will be allocated for oral or poster presentation. Authors are requested to indicate their preference when submitting. However, please note, that the Scientific Committee will make the final decision for the mode of presentation;
- 8. The final decision of the Scientific Committee will be announced 06th May 2022

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- 9. All accepted abstract submitters will receive confirmation by email. Please do not forget to indicate your correct email address when submitting your abstract, as well as the email addresses of the main author and the presenter (the author who will present the paper at the conference). The main author and the presenter can be the same person. They may also be identical to or different from the submitter);
- 10. Should it be realized, authors agree that their abstract will be published in the congress abstract book (pdf document, downloadable or printed). Please note, it would be published exactly as they have been provided and without any kind of editing;

ABSTRACT EDITING INSTRUCTIONS

All the Abstracts should be submitted according to the following editing instructions.

- 1. Maximum length (body of abstract): 250 words.
- 2. Abstract must be uploaded in **PDF** or **Word** A4 format (.doc; .docx) and must be one file only. The maximum size of the file is **1MB**. Please do not include any other information within the body of the abstract, such as the title or name of the authors, since these will be required by the system in other specific fields.
- 3. The title should be written in UPPER CASE (capitals). Please keep it as short as possible, clearly indicating the nature of the investigation, and please minimize the use of abbreviations;
- 4. Please avoid complex mathematical formulae;
- 5. Check spelling and grammar carefully. Direct reproduction from your electronically submitted abstract text means that any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific data will be reproduced as submitted.
- 6. The document can contain a maximum of 2 images in black and white, min. 300 dpi (resolution suitable for printing, if any) and base 8 cm.

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- 7. Abstracts should be structured in at least **six sections**, clearly mentioned as such: Title, authors and affiliation Background Aims Methods Results Conclusions
- 8. Please add the total number of the words at the end of the document;
- 9. The author should specify whether a poster or an oral presentation is preferred or if there is no preference;
- 10. A short presentation of the abstract may be requested for posters;
- 11. Applicants can submit more than 1 abstract as long as all applications represent separate pieces of work;
- 12. All authors (main author and co-authors) should be listed with their last names (family names) and their first name(s). If there are more than 6 authors on the application the names of the first 6 can be included but the remainder are described as 'et al';
- 13. **One** author must be identified as the presenter; the **presenter** commits to registering as a delegate to attend the congress and present the abstract;
- 14. Please indicate professional addresses of all authors: name of hospital, unit or laboratory, city and country. No other indications are to be given. Different affiliations will be automatically numbered;
- 15. Do not indent spaces on the first line of each paragraph. No space should be inserted between paragraphs. Use international standards for scientific articles;
- 16. Only standard abbreviations may be used without definition. Data must be given in units widely used in literature;
- 17. Drugs must be identified by their generic names;
- 18. A submitted abstract can be re-edited and modified until the submission deadline (30 April 2022). Submitted abstract cannot be edited after the submission deadline.
- 19. Authors who wish to withdraw their abstract must send a written request to: efc.congress@thetriumph.com
- 20. If you don't receive a mail with the confirmation of the successful upload of your abstract a week after the online submission please contact the Secretariat at efc.congress@thetriumph.com
